The symposium covered a number of activities including the exhibition by social entrepreneurs, plenaries discussing critical topics that enhanced the understanding of social entrepreneurship as well as tackle critical challenges. The SE symposium was officiated by H.E Maria Hakansson, the Ambassador Embassy of Sweden who noted that the SE Symposium aimed at addressing the critical challenges facing Social Entrepreneurs in Uganda while giving her opening remarks.

They are providing a safe and cheaper fuel option for the domestic population that has grown in urban centers in Kampala

Ms. Roy Nandawula, CEO Tupendane African Wear, a Uganda store that designs African fabrics imported from West Africa into stylish outfits for both Ladies & Gents to support the progression of the African creative economy. Ms. Roy is part of our 360 WEN accelerator program, a program funded and supported by USAID and Aspen Network of Development Entrepreneurs (ANDE). Through this training, she hopes to develop her marketing techniques in order to capture the international markets as well as increase overall revenue from her sales.


## NGOs SUPPORTED INTO THEIR SOCIAL ENTREPRENEUERSHIP JOURNEY




